This agreement grants qualified students a provisional early acceptance to LECOM. The LECOM phase of this program may be completed in Erie, PA, Greensburg, PA, Elmira, NY or in Bradenton, FL.

YEARLY DEADLINE:

End of Fall Semester

SELECTION CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior classification
- 3.2+ Science (BCPM) GPA
- 3.4+ Cumulative GPA
- 1240+ (CR + Math) SAT or 26+ ACT
- Must be recommended by the Health Careers Program

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- EAP students may be exempt from the Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) if ACT score is submitted.
- An American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine (AACOMAS) application is not required
