GIFT TYPE	DEFINITION
OUTRIGHT GIFT	A gift made to Spelman directly from an alumna in the form of cash, personal check or credit card.
RECURRING GIFT	A gift made to Spelman via automatic deduction from a credit or debit card on a monthly or annual basis.
MATCHING GIFT	A charitable gift made by a corporation which matches the gift of their employee to Spelman. The College must have proper documentation to record the matching gift.
SOFT CREDIT GIFT	Examples of soft credit gifts include matching gifts, from donor advised funds or family foundations, or an alumna giving through her own company.
PLEDGE	A documented promise to contribute a designated amount over a set timeframe. All pledge payments must conclude before your next reunion.
PLANNED GIFT	A documented gift to Spelman using a planned giving vehicle such as bequest intentions, insurance policies, etc.

Beacons of Excellence Award will be given to the top 3 classes with the largest total amount donated between July 1 2020 - May 16,2025 at 2 pm ET.

Through the Arch Award will be given to the class with the largest total dollars raised between July 1 2020 - May 16,2025 at 2 pm ET.

Supreme in Sisterhood Award will recognize the class with the highest percentage of alumnae who made outright gifts to Spelman between July 1 2020 - May 16,2025 at 2 pm ET.

In order for your Planned Gift to count towards your Reunion 2025 Class Gift, alumnae must be 65 years or older and the estate/planned gifts must have been made between July 1, 2020, and 2:00 PM, Friday, May 3, 2025. Documentation must be received to the Office of Planned Giving no later than 2:00 PM (ET), Friday, May 2, 2025.

REUNION GIVING FAQs

HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE FOR MY CLASS GIFT?

Your class Reunion Committee included a Class Letter with this newsletter. In this letter, they may have articulated a class giving goal. We encourage alumnae to make meaningful and thoughtful contributions to the College based on their individual capacity. If you are unsure, we suggest a gift that represents your class year (\$20.25, \$200.25, OR \$2,025.00) or increments of 1881 to honor the year of our founding (\$18.81, \$188.81, \$1881.00).

HOW WILL MY REUNION GIFT BE COUNTED?

All gifts to Spelman College, regardless of designation, are counted in your reunion class gift for the current fiscal year. You may designate your gift to an existing scholarship fund, program, or to **Spelman Strong** (formerly Annual Fund).

CAN I SUPPORT SPELMAN THROUGH A MATCHING GIFT FROM MY EMPLOYER?

Yes! Employee matches can double or even triple the impact of your reunion contribution. When you make your gift, notify your employer of your contribution to begin the match process. All match funds must be received or documented by the College by Friday, May 2, 2025 at 2pm ET. in order to count for the Reunion Philanthropy Awards. HOW CAN I CREATE A SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPELMAN STUDENTS?

HOW DO I GET A TRUE BLUE NECKLACE?
