

Dr. Selma Hortense Burke

Sculptor, Artist, Teacher

1900-1995

Selma H. Burke was born in Mooresville, North Carolina on December 31, 1900 to Neal Burke, minister and Mary Jackson Burke, mother and homemaker. Selma was the seventh of 10 siblings. She became interested in sculpturing as a young girl as she formed objects and small animals with her hands from the wash mud from a creek near her home. Her father encouraged her interest in art and sculpturing while her mother insisted that she acquire formal education in nursing. Selma graduated from Winston-Salem University with a Bachelors of Arts degree in 1922. After graduation from the St. Agnes School of Nursing at St. Augustine College in Raleigh, North Carolina, Selma became a registered nurse in 1924. Selma completed additional Nursing training in 1924 Women's Medical College in Philadelphia.

She was recommended for a private nursing position to a wealthy heiress and was employed with her for four years in New York. During this time, Selma accompanied her employer to various operas, exhibits, states and countries where her knowledge increased of the richness of New York and the world. Her desire to pursue art as a profession never left her thoughts so she began taking art courses in her spare time. As she immersed herself in work and education, she soon received an art scholarship to Columbia University and \$1,500 from the Julius Rosenwald Award for a paper she had written on sculpting materials. As her reputation grew, she also won the Boehler Foundation Award in 1936 which allowed her to travel to Europe and study under Michael Powoiny in Vienna, and several other famous international artists i.e., Maillois & Matisse, to name a few. She graduated from Columbia University with a Masters of Fine Arts degree in 1941.

In 1943, she won an international competition, and was chosen to design a portrait of President Franklin D. Roosevelt. After sketching the President in person, she produced a bronze plaque of the President which is installed at the Recorder of Deeds Building in Washington D.C. From her famous portrait and plaque of President Roosevelt, the image on the dime originated per the National Archives and Records Administration of the Franklin D. Roosevelt Library in Hyde Park, New York. However, Selma never received proper credit for her contribution to the image on the dime since the coin bears the initials of the engraver, John Sinnock.

From the 1940's through the 1970's, Selma supported renowned artists and taught art to children and adults. She opened up the Selma Burke School of Sculpture in New York, City, and she also established the Selma Burke Art Center in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. She enjoyed visiting elementary schools where she encouraged art and diligence to children whom she adored. She often taught children and adults her father's saying to her as a young girl "...always do your best ...and 'then some'".

At the age of 70, Dr. Burke completed a Doctorate in Arts and Letters at Livingstone College, Salisbury, North Carolina. At the age of 80, in 1980, Burke produced her last monumental of a statue of Martin Luther King, Jr. located in Marshall Park in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Her sculptures have been exhibited in many museums around the world. Some of her famous sculptures are: Fallen Angel, Peace, Martin L. King, Jr., Duke Ellington, Family, and Medea.

Selma Burke died on August 29, 1995 at the age of 94 in New Hope, PA. She had three husbands: married Durant Woodward, c.1925; widowed, c.1926; married and divorced Claude McKay twice; married Herman Kobbe, 1949; widowed, early 1950s. Mourning her passing is her beloved dog, "E.D", and family members. She had a host of friends and god-children from all cultures. Dr. Burke has received numerous awards, honors, certificates and thank you's from various Colleges, Federal, State and International Agencies, Organizations and children as her life revolved around giving and sharing her art and self with the world.

Many of her sculptures are housed at Winston Salem, her alma mater. Several pieces of sculpture are also exhibited and stored in the Spelman College Museum.
